After Activity

You Keep	Nothing

To Do

Say: Faith is believing something even when you can't see it or even always recognize it. We can have faith in a lot of things we can't see. Gravity, air—and even invisible pictures!

- 1. Give each kid a pen and a piece of paper.
- 2. Kids use invisible ink to write or draw some good things they believe about Jesus. Read the back of this guide to give ideas to kids who need help.
- 3. Kids **shine** the black light on their papers and **share** their ideas with the group. Note: Preview each picture before sharing with the group to check for appropriateness.

Say: We believed that all of us had drawings on these papers even when we couldn't see them—that's faith. Faith in Jesus is even better! Even though we can't see Him, we can trust Him because He is all powerful, all good, all loving, and never ever changes.

4. If time allows, kids decorate papers with their invisible ink.

Review the Verse: Find Bibles in room. Look up verse together. Talk about what's different and/or the same since in-room Bible is a different translation. Hebrews 11:1 NIRV Faith is being sure of what we hope for. It is being certain of what we do not see.

• What does this Bible verse make you think about?

Choose a Question to Get Your Group Talking

- If someone didn't know what faith is, what would you tell them?
- What are some invisible things people put their faith in every day?
- How do you think faith in Jesus is different from faith in other things like air, gravity, or germs?

Wrap Up

- Pray together.
- Do the small group activity again or play a game like Telephone or I Spy.

Leader Tip

Without friends a kid knows and trusts. Konnect can feel like a big, scary place. Help kids talk with each other, learn names, and build friendships.

Per Kid	1 Novelty eraser
Per Group	10 Opaque cups

After Activity

Kids Keep	Their eraser
You Keep	Cups (save to reuse)

To Do

Say: When you really like something, it's hard to give it away to help someone else, but it honors God when we have enough faith to do that. When we trust God will meet all our needs, our faith grows so we can give generously. Let's play a game where we'll find erasers, then give them away to practice faith-filled generosity!

- 1. Place cups upside down in the middle of the group.
- 2. Kids close their eyes and leader hides an eraser underneath one or two of the cups.
- 3. Kids **open their eyes** and **choose** a cup.
- 4. Slide each kid's chosen cup in front of them.
- 5. When all cups are chosen, **count** to three and kids look under their cups at the same time.
- 6. If a kid finds an eraser, they **give** it to someone who doesn't have one.
- 7. Repeat steps 1-6 until every kid has an eraser.
- 8. If time allows, ask if any of the kids want to donate their eraser so you can keep playing. Play the game with their eraser. Note: Thank them for sharing and give their eraser back once time is up.

To Do

Sav: If we want our bodies to get stronger, we have to use them every day. If we want our faith to get stronger, we have to use it every day, too. Let's play a game to remind us to put our faith in action!

- 1. Challenge kids to do sets of fun actions to exercise their bodies or their faith while you say the point:
 - Read an action from the back of this leader guide.
 - Kids guess if it exercises their body or their faith, then you reveal the answer.
 - Slowly say the point out loud for your group while they do the action.
 - When you finish reading the point, kids stop.
 - · Repeat as time allows.

Say: Now that was a workout! All that exercising keeps our bodies healthy. And remember—we keep our faith in Jesus healthy by doing good things like reading our Bibles, praying to God, worshiping, obeying our parents and leaders, and helping others.

2. If time allows, play the game again with kids choosing the action for each set.

Choose a Question to Get Your Group Talking

- If a person did some good things just to make God love them more, what would you tell them?
- What are some good things people can do to keep their faith in Jesus healthy?
- What do you think is good about keeping your faith healthy?
- What do you think happens if you don't do anything at all to keep your faith healthy?

Wrap Up

- Prav together.
- Do the small group activity again or play a game like 20 Questions or Simon Says.

Leader Tip

Follow up! Try jotting down prayer requests so you'll remember to pray about them. Ask how the situation is going next week.

EXERCISE FAITH ACTIVITY SUPPLEMENT FAITH // WEEK 3 // FAITH IN ACTION

Today's Point (say while kids do their action): I can show my faith to grow my faith.

Actions (read what to act out if it's a "grow your faith" action):

- Push-up (body)
- Pray (faith, fold hands and bow head)
- Frog jump (body)
- Sing to God (faith, sing "la, la, la")
- Sit-up (body)
- Obey your parents (faith, show thumbs up)
- Toe touch (body)
- Log roll (body)

- Learn from the Bible (faith, pretend to read a Bible)
- Dizzy spin (body)
- Run in place (body)
- Cat stretch (body)
- Be kind to someone who's sad (faith, give yourself a hug)
- Give generously to help someone (faith, pretend to share a toy with someone)
- Plank (body)

- Crab walk (body)
- Tell someone about how much Jesus loves them (faith, give high fives to everyone in the group)
- Worm wiggle (body)
- Ninja kick (body)
- Bear crawl (body)

Adaptations if a kid in your group has a disability:

- Let the kid say the actions for the whole group.
- Use actions the kid is able to do. For example:
 - Clap hands

o Blink eyes

Tap legs

Count as fast as you can

- Wiggle fingers
- Raise the roof
