

## **WEEK ONE: SHEEP AND GOATS**

- I. Simple theological progression leading up to our main passage today.
  - a. First, we are saved by grace through faith, not by works... Ephesians 2:8-10
  - b. But out of a saving faith flows obedience. Romans 1:5
  - c. And in our obedience, we find out what pleases the Lord. Ephesians 5:8-11
  - d. This process can be applied to anything: our mouth, thoughts, marriage, work, etc!
  - e. Our focus today: Out of our obedience, we care for the most vulnerable of society which really pleases the Lord.
- II. Caring for the oppressed, the most vulnerable is God's heart!
  - a. Supporting passage: Isaiah 58:6-10
  - b. Main passage: Matthew 25:31-46
- III. A few things to take away from these passages:
- Caring is not optional...it's commanded.
- It's not "our" time, talents and treasures... they're "His". We're all given 168 hours per week!
- Parents, as you disciple your kids, "develop their potential" and "take them along".
- Jesus gave us 6 areas to focus on: hunger, thirst, shelter, clothes, sickness, prison.
- This "helping" should become natural to us.
- There are times when we need to use discernment due to limited time and resources.
- Final reminder: Caring is either "to" Jesus or "away from" him.
