



COOKIES

In Matthew 25:35, Jesus tells us, among other things, to minister to those in prison. The Kairos Prison Ministry does just that...goes into prisons, as the hands and feet of Christ, to show them Christ in a real way and encourage them to make Him part of their lives moving forward.

Kairos weekends are very powerful, described sometimes as, "seeing the Holy Spirit on Steroids". A big part of this ministry is the outpouring of Christian "Agape" love from the outside.

### There are several ways this happens:

Provide 24/7 prayer cover for the weekend – Thursday, April 12 through Sunday, April 15. (All cookies will need to be at church by April 1).

Attend the Closing event on the afternoon April 15.

Have your life group create a simple posture about Christ's unconditional love and forgiveness.

Bake cookies – we need about 8,000 DOZEN home-baked cookies for each weekend. These are used at our tables during talks and discussions during the weekend. A dozen are also given to EVERY inmate and staffer on the compound of that prison. Each team member is responsible for bringing in about 200 dozen home-baked cookies, brownies, no-bakes, rice-krispy treats or any other kind of cookie you want to bake.

Help us fund the weekend. It costs about \$7,000 put on a Kairos Weekend and the Volunteer team is responsible for raising that money.

### Here's the ASK:

Please keep the Kairos Team and the Kairos weekend itself in prayer.

Please consider making 2, 4, 6, 8, or 10 dozen home-baked cookies packaged 1 dozen to a zip-loc bag and return them to Discover on Easter Sunday.

Consider attending the Weekend Closing event on April 15.

Consider taping a \$1 bill (or more) to each of your cookie bags or a love offering to the Kairos Prison Ministry with MaCl #8 on the memo line.
