Abraham, Sarah, and Isaac (Genesis 22:1-14)

Similarities between Isaac and Jesus

- > Isaac and Jesus were miraculous, promised births
- > Isaac and Jesus were named by God
- > Isaac and Jesus were rejected by brothers/family
- > Isaac and Jesus were beloved sons
- > Isaac and Jesus agreed to be sacrificed
- > Isaac and Jesus carried the wood for their sacrifice
- > Isaac was a potential sacrifice; Jesus was the ultimate sacrifice

3 questions about my faith:

1. Does my faith act or only talk?
2. What's hard for me to offer to God in faith?
3. Do I have faith that God can do great things in and through my life?

My role: have faith in God. God's role: do great things.
