2. By purchasing, eating, or doing this, is God's purpose enhanced or diminished?

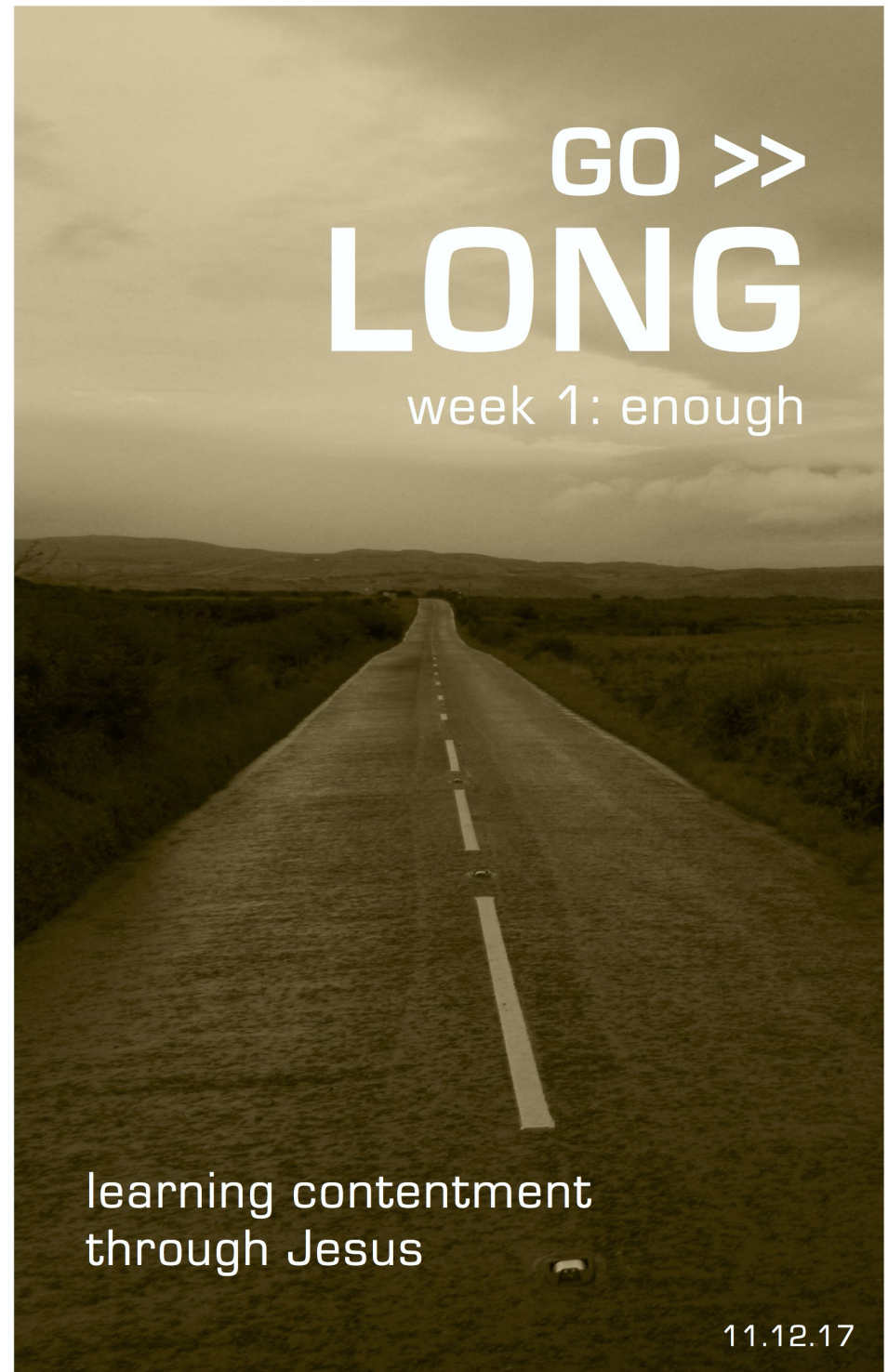
