Moses and Jesus

- Nearly killed as infants by evil rulers (Exodus 1:22; Matthew 2:16)
- Adopted as children (Exodus 2:10; Matthew 1:24-25)
- God also worked outside the spotlight (Exodus 2:21-23; Luke 2:52)
- Shepherds (Exodus 3:1; John 10:11)
- Brought freedom to slaves (Exodus 6:13; Luke 4:18-21)
- Offered their lives to save others (Exodus 32:32; John 10:11)

So what? (us)

- The enemy wants to destroy us (1 Peter 5:8)
- Be adopted, and help others be adopted (John 1:12; Matt 28:19; Psa 82:3-4)
- God forms us personally, not publicly (John 15:5; Matt 4:19; Gal 5:22-23)
- Care for (shepherd) people (John 10:14; Philippians 2:4)
- Help release people from slavery (2 Corinthians 5:18)
- Lay down our lives for others (1 John 3:16-18)

No comparison

- Moses: prophet who proclaimed the Law (Exodus 20:1 — 24:3-4)
- Jesus: fulfilled the Law and Prophets (Deut 18:15; Matt 5:17; Luke 24:27)
