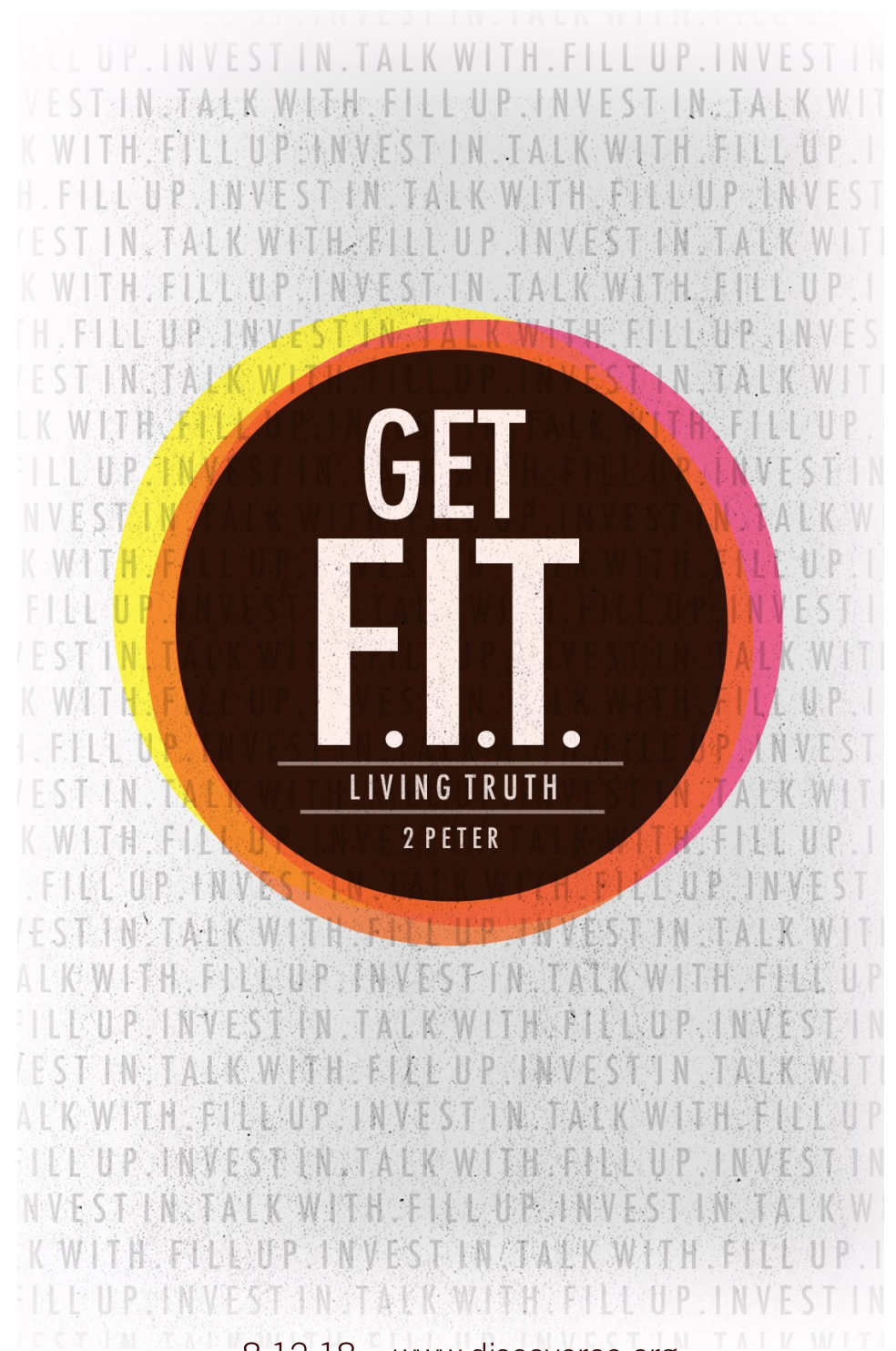

#### THREAT EXTINGUISHER IMPLEMENTATION

Discover and Tree of Life is in the process of implementing a new program that is a powerful combination of a panic system and a proven effective defense option. The program is called Threat Extinguisher. These are canisters of a tear gas that can be used to deter anyone threatening our attendees or students. This is a system of alerting people in the building there is a threat and its location, notifying the local authorities, which in our case the Dublin Police and defending ourselves from the threat until help arrives. The equipment has been installed but not activated yet. This will be done when the appropriate people can be trained on the best way to utilize the system. In the meantime, please **DO NOT touch** this equipment and remind your youngsters to leave them alone.
