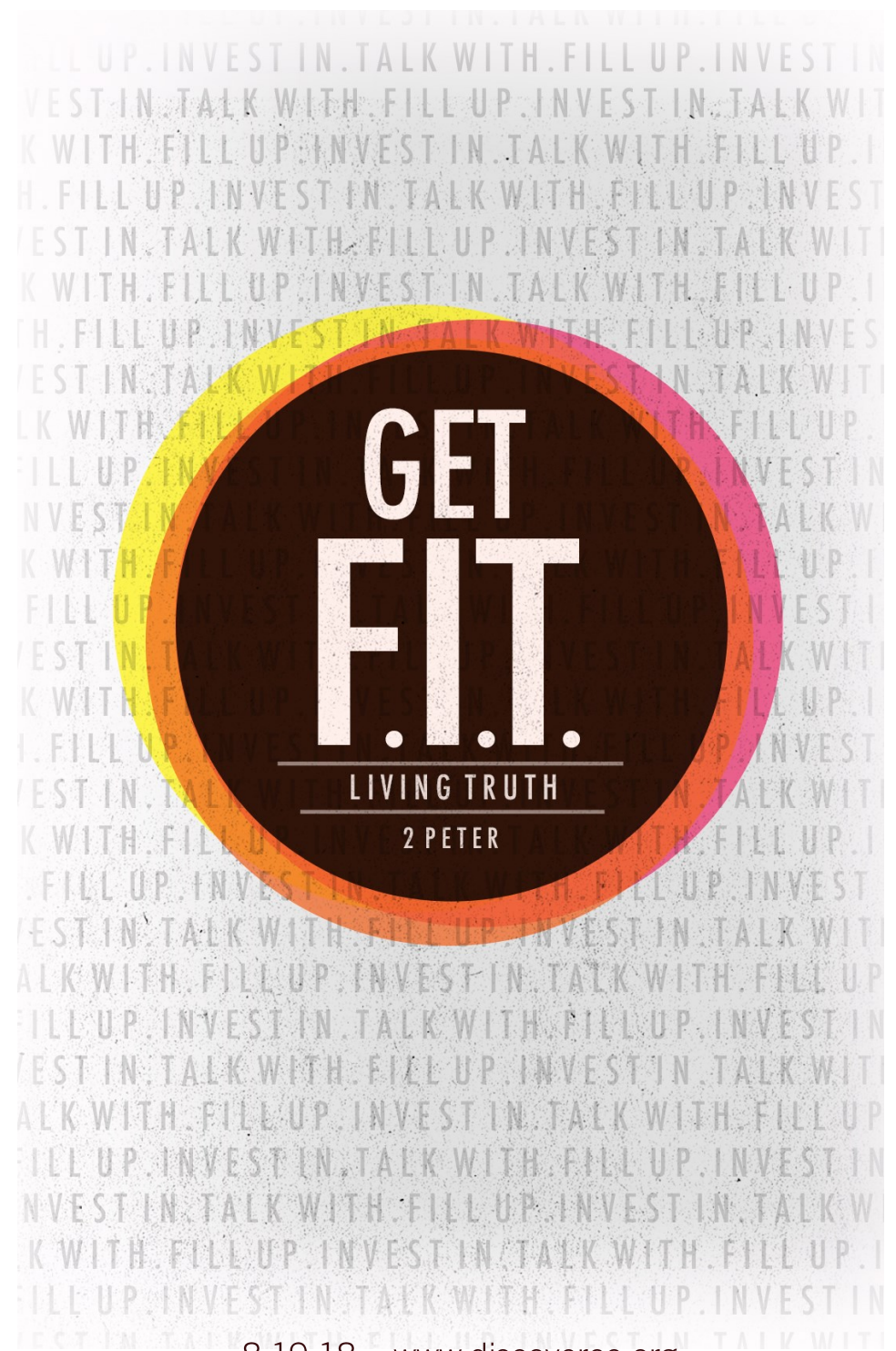

WORSHIP SERVICE

Most weeks we eat the bread and drink the juice as they are passed to us. If it is different this week, it will be made clear in the service. "Gluten free bread is available at the Welcome Center."

Singing: Most of the music we use is contemporary in nature. Please join in offering thanks to God as you feel comfortable.

Message: The teaching is from the Bible, designed to apply to our lives today. If you don't have a Bible, please take one (from the Welcome Center in the lobby) as our gift. If you have a tablet or smartphone please be sure to connect to Live Event each week to follow along with and participate in the message. Simply download the YouVersion Bible application, connect to our guest WIFI (password: [dcc43017](#)), slide or scroll to "Events", search our event by typing in our zip code (43017), and finally open our Live Event and follow along!

CHILDREN: Nursery-Grade 6 are securely checked-in for dynamic, age appropriate teaching and worship. The Children's Welcome Center is the place to start.

YOUTH: High School and Middle School have separate classes at 9:00, and worship at the 10:30 service. For classes, the Youth Center is the place to start.

Not in a life group or D-group yet? Don't miss the camaraderie, Bible study, food, laughter and caring that takes place in a group. Group life is a huge part of the culture of Discover. Acts 2:42-47 shows the importance of Christians gathering together 2000 years ago as the church grew in the face of opposition! Life groups usually meet weekly, consisting of between 8 to 16 people. Groups meet at various times around northwest Columbus in either homes or at the church. D-groups, a.k.a. discipleship groups, usually consist of 4 to 5 people and meet for a year to a year and a half. Bible study is deeper as well as accountability.
