4. **The BIG MOVE** – will take place in the Marysville area as we unload the walls from the truck at the final building site.
5. **The BIG ASK** – if you are not able to participate physically, you can still be a part of the action by donating to offset the cost of the project.

GO SERVE OPPORTUNITIES

Here are the trips we are considering for 2021:

NAVAJO NATION: This trip would be through Lifeline Christian Missions. The purpose of this trip is to work with the missionary family and their staff in support of their ministry around Winslow, AZ and the Navajo Reservation. This would likely entail a wide spectrum of activities such as building and grounds maintenance, homeless outreach, and community support. Timing of this trip is thought to be mid to late summer.

WISE: The purpose of this trip would be to meet and get to know the new Executive Director of WISE, Daniel Wheat and his family. We would also be involved in ministering to the needs of the family, the staff and students on campus, working with the local churches, and building/grounds maintenance. Timing of this trip is thought to be late summer to early fall.

PIEDRAS NEGRAS: This trip would be through Crossroads Missions. This could potentially be a medical mission trip depending on timing, however, people with no medical background would also be encouraged to participate. Beyond ministering to the medical needs of the local community, we would be working with their ministry partners, and doing building and grounds maintenance.
