SERMON NOTES

Today in worship we continue with our yearlong series called "The Bible Year," in which we are reading the Scriptures all the way through together, from cover to cover, from Genesis all the way through Revelation.



Recently we began reading a part of the Bible sometimes called The Minor Prophets, which consists of twelve shorter books written by or about messengers whom God sends to God's people. Among the prophetic books we read in the past week was that of the prophet Habakkuk. We do not know much about Habakkuk's ministry – what we have are his writings, some of which consist of Psalm-like prayers to God. Like the biblical figure Job, Habakkuk asks God why there is so much violence and injustice and seemingly senseless suffering in the world. The message Habakkuk receives is a call to patient trust and enduring hope— a message that reminds the prophet that the temporary events of life are not always an accurate reflection of God's character, or God's long-term purpose. In response, Habakkuk declares that whatever may be happening to him in life, he will continue to rejoice in the goodness of God.

Today's Scripture:

Habakkuk 1:1-4; 2:1-4; 3:17-19 (NRSVue) KEY VERSES:

"2 O Lord, how long shall I cry for help, and you will not listen?
Or cry to you "Violence!" and you will not save?

3 Why do you make me see wrongdoing and look at trouble?
Destruction and violence are before me; strife and contention arise.

4 So the law becomes slack, and justice never prevails.

Then the Lord answered me and said: Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so that a runner may read it. 3 For there is still a vision for the appointed time; it speaks of the end and does not lie.

If it seems to tarry, wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay . . .

Though the fig tree does not blossom, and no fruit is on the vines . . .
