SERVICE NOTES



During 2025, we have dedicated ourselves to the yearlong series called "The Bible Year," in which we have been reading through the entire Bible. With just six Sundays left in 2025, we are now reading the epistles written by Paul. Today's message is taken from Ephesians. Ephesus was a multiethnic city, there were Egyptians, Persians, Romans, Syrians and others living there. As Gentile believers came into the house churches, there was some tension created between them with the Jewish believers. Paul writes to express how Christ has taken away the barriers and that through the cross of Jesus all people are invited into reconciliation with God. In Christ, we are fellow citizens and members of God's family.

Today's Scripture:

Ephesians 2:11-22 KEY VERSES:

¹⁴ For he is our peace; in his flesh he has made both into one and has broken down the dividing wall, that is, the hostility between us, ¹⁵ abolishing the law with its commandments and ordinances, that he might create in himself one new humanity in place of the two, thus making peace, ¹⁶ and might reconcile both to God in one body through the cross, thus putting to death that hostility through it. ¹⁷ So he came and proclaimed peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near, ¹⁸ for through him both of us have access in one Spirit to the Father. ¹⁹ So then, you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God...
