Pastor's Pen...

I have always loved movies. After college I managed a couple video stores. Even though I was far removed from God and the church at this stage of my life, I could not avoid seeing religious messages in secular films. Many movies never mention the name of God, but nonetheless center on the great themes of sin & salvation, brokenness & redemption.

On a recent Monday we began a four week Faith and Film series by watching and discussing *Groundhog Day*. I believe this movie is one of the greatest redemption stories ever committed to film. Its lead character, Phil Connors (played by Bill Murray), is a selfish, cynical and arrogant weatherman who dreads being sent on assignment to cover the Groundhog Day festivities in Punxsutawney, PA.

Through some unexplained time loop, Phil is forced to relive the same day countless times. For a time, Phil's weird circumstances heighten his selfishness. Then he goes through a period of despair. At long last he has a breakthrough. It's only once Phil has led the most selfless day possible that Phil is released from his temporal prison.

Sometimes I wish I had the gift of reliving a day until I get it right, but, alas, it hasn't happened yet. The days march onward. And in spite of the fact that I don't see daily evidence of this, I haven't lost my hope that over time sin and selfishness will decrease their hold over me.

John Wesley, founder of Methodism, believed that it was not only possible but expected that Christians would grow in holiness of heart and life. Wesley emphasized that God not only justifies the believer (by doing away with past sin) but also sanctifies her (freeing her for faithful living going forward).

If you cooperated with the Holy Spirit, how far could the process of sanctification take you? While this was probably his most controversial doctrine, Wesley taught that Christians could fulfill Jesus' command (Matthew 5:48) and become perfect in love in this life. By perfection John Wesley didn't mean you would never make a mistake on a crossword puzzle or spill a drink. He meant that you would never consciously do anything out of a motive other than love for God and neighbor.

Maybe "Christian perfection" sounds farfetched to you. But is it possible to love God and neighbor a little better today than yesterday and tomorrow that today? I sure hope so. If the Holy Bible and our Methodist theological heritage aren't enough to convince you that it's possible to grow in grace, and a Bill Murray movie can help, so be it!

Have you heard about one of congregation's best ways of providing care and support?

What is Stephen Ministry? Stephen Ministry is the one-to-one caring ministry that many congregations - including GCUMC - use to minister to hurting people. Stephen Ministry congregations equip and empower lay caregivers - called Stephen Ministers - to provide high-quality, confidential, Christ-centered care. It is necessary for anyone becoming a Stephen Minister to go through an extensive training period.

Who can be a Care Receiver? Care Receivers are people from all walks of life, members and others from the community, who receive care from a Stephen Minister. Care Receivers are going through tough times in their lives such as grief, divorce, job loss, chronic or terminal illness or some other crisis. Men are paired with men and women with women. The Care Receiver's information is held in strictest confidentiality.

Thanks for Caring for Your Neighbors in Need

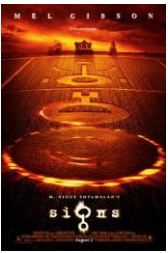

Faith and Film Series Continues:

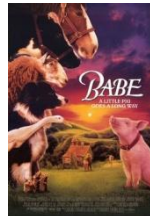
