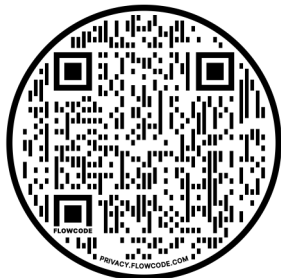

Conflict Among Christians

November 16, 2025

As Christians we are called to think and behave in ways contrary to the world. We have a focus on Christ and Godliness. We value morality and walk in Jesus' footsteps as best we can. We try to approach people with understanding and mercy. We want to be good emissaries for Christ in our communities. We are generally successful in living out this commitment even though we struggle and fail sometimes.

One place I see us fail often and miserably is when it comes to conflict, not so much with those outside the Faith, but with our fellow Christians. I have long heard the saying: "You hurt the ones you love." I think that is true. When we are angry with or hurt by our brothers or sisters in Christ we often revert to the values of the world in dealing with it. We lash out with hurtful words and actions. We complain about it to all who will listen. We demand "satisfaction" and penance. We bear grudges. None of which reflects the values of Christ. We really need a way to check ourselves before embarking on the world's methods for dealing with conflict.

There are three things I think the Christian should reflect on when one of these conflicts arises:

- **Who is God?** God is the only truly just being. When sin is committed it is against Him. God is holy and just, only He is righteous in judging.
- **Who am I?** The Bible says we are all sinners. None are righteous except through the blood of Christ. We are human: our judgement is human, our perspective is human and our understanding is human. We often demand justice when we really need mercy!
- **What would Jesus have me do?** Forgive as we have been forgiven. Love others before ourselves. Seek peace and understanding. Behave as those belonging to God and wearing the name of Christ.

Going forward let us all try to address conflict, not as the world does, as Christians!
