The God Who Sees (Psalm 33)

So many songs are about relationships. Maybe all of them to one degree or another. This is true of the Psalms as well. When we sing hymns together, we are in relationship with each other and with God.

Psalm 33 is a beautiful song about our God and his relationship with his people. We worship the God who created the heavens and the earth, and he is worthy of our praise. The proper response to seeing what the Lord has made is awe. The beauty and power and complexity of his world, his universe boggles the mind. From the smallest objects we have discovered to the largest, we are learning that there is more beyond what we can see and know.

It only makes sense, then, to have a relationship with the God that created everything and has a desire to love us and be in relationship with us. God's word, his word!, created the earth.

There are a couple of things in this song that are worth considering today. "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord." What is remarkable here is that the nation is not named. Whatever nation fears God will be blessed. This does not mean connecting a flag with the church. It means a people who have a relationship with God.

Before any act of faith can be performed, there must first exist a relationship based on faith rather than on morality or doctrine. Faith is first, then we learn what that means. This is a hard concept for us to grasp, but it is essential. The "fear of the Lord" is relational. Righteousness is relational. We are not righteous because we do the right thing. We are righteous because the one we worship is righteous.

God is active in Psalm 33. He "looks down from heaven." He "loves righteousness and justice." He fashions the hearts of the sons of men. He delivers our souls from death. This is a song of hope and of promise. It is a song of rejoicing because of who God is and what he does for us.

This morning, we are going to read and consider what Psalm 33 has to say to us in 2026. It is a reminder for us to keep our hearts and lives turned in the right direction. What does it mean to be in a relationship as a group of people with a God that loves righteousness and justice?

We have a wonderful God who has a wonderful message. May we carry that with us wherever we go.
