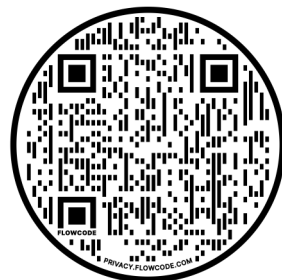

## Living One Day at a Time

*(Luke 2:41-52)*

Father’s Day reminds us that some of the most meaningful things in life are built slowly over time. Strong families, deep faith, lasting character, and spiritual maturity are usually not formed in a single moment. They are shaped one day at a time through steady love, faithful example, and daily choices.

We live in a culture that loves instant results. We want instant success, instant change, and sometimes even instant spiritual growth. Yet throughout Scripture, we see that God most often works progressively rather than instantly. He forms hearts, shapes character, and grows faith over time.

One of the most overlooked passages in the life of Jesus teaches us this truth. In Luke 2, we find the only story recorded from Jesus’ childhood. Between His birth and the beginning of His public ministry, nearly thirty years passed quietly. Before Jesus preached sermons, performed miracles, or went to the cross, He spent years growing faithfully in ordinary life.

Luke tells us that Jesus’ family went to Jerusalem for Passover “every year.” Worship, Scripture, and devotion to God were part of the rhythm of their home. Those habits mattered. Long before Jesus stood before crowds publicly, He was being shaped privately through daily faithfulness.

Often, we want dramatic spiritual moments while overlooking the importance of ordinary obedience. Yet God frequently works through routines such as prayer, worship, Scripture reading, encouragement, and consistent trust.

When Jesus stayed behind in the temple at twelve years old, we see a glimpse of Jesus expressing His unique relationship with the Father and the mission He had come to fulfill.

Then Luke summarizes those hidden years with these words: “And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and with people” (Luke 2:52).

Jesus grew.

That growth happened gradually—day by day, year by year, in faithfulness and even obscurity. The same is true in our lives. Spiritual maturity rarely happens all at once. It happens through small acts of obedience repeated consistently over time.

That truth matters for fathers as well as all parents, and grandparents. The everyday moments such as praying with your children, bringing your family to worship, speaking truth, showing kindness, and modeling faithfulness, may not seem dramatic in the moment, but God often uses those ordinary habits to shape lives for eternity.

May we trust God’s process and faithfully follow Him one day at a time.
