

## Honduras 2025!

What a wonderful time we live in. Technology and relative peace have made it easy and affordable for brothers and sisters in different parts of the world to travel to help each other and have fellowship across cultures, languages, and economics. For twenty years the congregation here has been working with Marvin Rivera and Torch Missions to further the cause of Christ in Honduras.

Four of our team this year were not born when Pennyrile first went to Honduras. That speaks to the patience and good work this congregation has done.

This morning, we are going to hear from the seven of us that travelled this past June to work in Santa Ana, Ojojona, La Trinidad, and Tegucigalpa. Our group joins groups from other congregations to do more than we could do on our own. They help us with our projects, and we help them with theirs. This year Pennyrile funded the construction of two houses, a mobile medical clinic, and the purchase of dry goods and fresh market fruit and vegetables, and provided speakers for the Ladies Day hosted by the Kennedy congregation.

Most days the seven of us worked in different places or had different tasks to do. All together the group worked on six houses, a church building, worked at Reach One Teach One, visited the pediatric and women's centers at Hospital Escuela, bought, sorted, and delivered 100 bags of dry goods and 50 five-gallon buckets of fresh food, visited a children's home, and served the community of La Trinidad with a mobile medical clinic.

Because of the generosity of this congregation the community of Aragua has a new school building, the first-grade class at Escuela Juan Lindo in Santa Ana has recorders and books to learn music. Since we have been there, a new congregation in Ojojona has hired a minister.

Each of our team has chosen one or more of the projects to talk about. Emily will tell us about her visit to the women's center at the hospital. Ezra will tell us about the Sunday church service we attended and the pediatric ward of the hospital, Cady will tell us about the food distribution and her experience at the hospital as well. Landon will tell us about building block houses. Kellie will share her part of the clinic and the ladies' day. Elizabeth will update us on her work at the clinic and her visit to Jovenes in Camino where Marvin's brother, Carlos, is the director.

This is also a good time to share that Marvin has been asked to speak again this year at the gathering of Latin American ministers and missionaries in Guatemala later this year. Marvin and Lourdes have distinguished themselves in the work they have done in the church and professionally. They are worth our continuing support.


