

No Condemnation!

(Romans 7:13-8:27)

Jesus (to the gathered crowd, stones in hand), "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her.'

Crowd drops stones.

Jesus (to the woman about to be stoned), "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" Woman: "No one, Lord."

Jesus: "Neither do I condemn you; go, and do not sin again."

Psalm 32:1-4:

Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.

Blessed is the man to whom the LORD imputes no iniquity,

and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

When I declared not my sin, my body wasted away, through my groaning all day long.

For day and night thy hand was heavy upon me;

my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.

Paul to those gathered at the synagogue in Antioch of Pisidia (Acts 13:38-39)

"Let it be known to you therefore, brethren, that through this man forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you, and by him every one that believes is freed from everything from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses."

There is within all of us a battle that rages. Paul expresses that battle in his own words in what is nearly a tongue twister in Romans 7:13-20. We, as believers in God through Christ, know that we have been freed from sin and the fear of death. We also know our thoughts and actions do not always live up to what God expects of us. Anyone who reads the Bible and takes it seriously knows how Paul feels. There is great rejoicing and delight in the Law of God, but that same law in which we delight condemns us. Not because it is a failure or because it is faulty but because we are.

The power of Christ and the Spirit of God is that if we are in Christ that condemnation holds no power over us. There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus! We are set free from that law of sin and death. The law of God is perfect, but it is weakened by our flesh. That is why Paul tells us that we are to now live by the Spirit.

The Spirit of God frees us from the worry that we have when we fail. The Spirit of God makes it possible for us to keep the law like we have never been able to keep it before. The Spirit of God means that we belong to him – not to the world or things that are in the world. This also means that while we understand that we need to learn to navigate and use the systems of this world, they are not the solution. All those systems – even the best of them – lead to death. The Spirit leads to life.
