

**Knights of Columbus Council 8733
2018 \$500 Scholarship Application**

A. To be eligible you must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- (1) be a current High School Senior who is due to graduate in May/June 2018;
- (2) will be attending a 2-yr college, 4-yr college, or trade school in September, 2018;
- (3) are a Holy Eucharist Parishioner.

B. To apply for consideration please submit the following electronically as a Microsoft Word document to Mr. Gary Williams, PGK, Knights of Columbus Council 8733 at sen03chemap@comcast.net by **midnight, April 3, 2018.**

1. A maximum 4-page document. (Includes cover page)
2. The cover page needs to have the following information and can be formatted anyway you desire. (The only person seeing the cover page will be Mr. Williams.)
 - a. Your full name
 - b. Parent(s) or Guardian(s) name(s)
 - c. Address
 - d. Home Phone Number
 - e. The High School you are attending
 - f. The 2-yr/4-yr college or trade school that you will be attending or plan to be attending in Sept 2018. (If you finalize where you will attend after submitting the application, please email the school's name to Mr. Williams so that he can update your cover page.
3. The remaining pages will contain the required passage and your essay.

You are to select any bible passage and explain how it has influenced and/or continues to influence your life.

Page 2:

- a. Please copy the bible passage that you choose. Include the book, chapter, and verse(s). (i.e. Genesis 4: 12-14)
- b. The verse page contains no other identification and may be formatted any way that you choose.

Page 3 (4)

- a. The essay is to be a maximum length of 2 pages.
- b. It is to be double-spaced with all margins 1 inch.
- c. You must use 12 pt Times New Roman.
- d. The essay page or pages is/are to contain no identification, just the essay!

D. Selection process

1. Mr. Williams will assign a code randomly after all essays have been received (F1, F2, etc. or M1, M2, etc.)
2. He will remove the cover page and write the code at the top of the essay pages.
3. A copy of each essay will be given to each member of the assessment team.
4. The team members will separately read and rank the male and female essays, 1, 2, 3, etc.
5. The team will meet and add up the rankings for each submitted essay. The male and female essay with the lowest number will then be given to Mr. Williams. These will be the recipients of the two scholarships that will be awarded to the winners at the May 24th, 2018 Knights of Columbus Awards meeting, held at 7:30 PM in Hoffmann Hall.
