

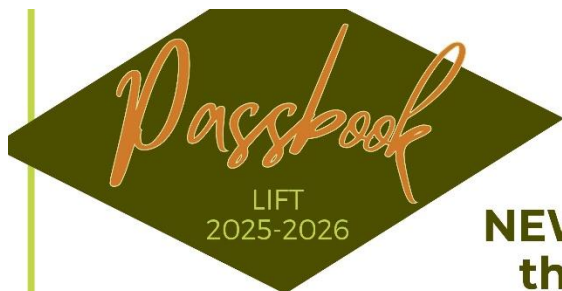

So what is the Passbook?

The Passbook is an opportunity for your family to connect with the parish in a variety of ways.

These opportunities, unless noted, are family experiences – that means that one adult or guardian needs to present with your child.

There are four different kinds of opportunities:

- **Catechetical:** Catechesis is an education in the faith so the catechetical sessions will provide some hands-on instruction for the whole family to enjoy and use right away in the home.
- **Prayer:** Different forms of prayer will be introduced and practiced together in the community.
- **Service:** Service is important to the formation of our kids in the faith because it shows us ways and helps us practice to love our neighbor well.
- **Community:** Our faith is gifted in community so these experiences will help us to grow together as a faith community.

So what is my goal?

The goal is to have each child collect eight (8) Passbook experiences with at least one of each type. For example, you could have one **catechetical**, one **prayer**, two **community** and four **service** experiences.

To track your progress, your child will receive a stamp on his or her Passbook at each experience and write down the event and date in the space provided.

What kinds of experiences can I choose from?
