## Daily Mass

**9:00 am** in the Daily Chapel—Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday. (Communion service offered on Tuesdays). The Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and summit of our Catholic faith. Hear the words of the Gospel, reflect on the daily homily, and worship God in the Eucharist. Followed by the Litany of Prayer for Persecuted Christians

## Adoration in the Daily Chapel—every Wednesday

**9:30 am** in the chapel following morning mass. Continues until **7:30 pm** ending with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Join us in silent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament for your needs, the needs of the parish and for our Christian brothers and sisters who are being persecuted for the faith. Spend a few minutes, an hour or whatever time your schedule permits.

## Confession—Every Saturday from 3:30 pm—4:30 pm and Wednesdays during Lent except March 23 and 30 at 10:00 am—12:00 pm, 2:00 pm— 4:00 pm, 8:00 pm—9:00 pm.

The peace of mind and soul which this sacrament imparts to us in one for which there is no substitute. Maybe you have been away from celebrating this sacrament for a long time, maybe you have some initial fears. Put your fears to rest and come and celebrate God's forgiveness.

**Stations of the Cross—Fridays of Lent—February 16, 23, March 2, 9, 16, 23. 9:45 am** in the main worship space following morning Mass. Stations on Good Friday, March 30 will be outdoors weather permitting at 7:00 pm. See the Holy Week document for more details of Holy Week.

**Weekend Mass—5:00 pm Saturday, 8:30 am, 10:30 am, 6:00 pm Sunday.** Lent is a time of spiritual renewal. Make a commitment to join us each week during Lent. Bring your family and invite a friend. We offer Children's Word and our pre-school childcare program every week at 5:00pm Saturday, 8:30am and 10:30am Sunday masses.

## Kidzone—Offered at 5:00 pm Saturday, 8:30 am and 10:30 am Sunday Masses

At KIDZONE we offer play and worship for kids ages 6 months - 5 years old. We gather for the duration of Mass and provide your child with a warm environment for him/her to play, connect with other children in our faith community and worship through songs and bible stories.

## Children's Liturgy of the Word—Offered at 5:00 pm Saturday, 8:30 am and 10:30 am Sunday Masses.

Young Believers (grades 1-3) and Faith Explorers (grades 4-6) This Lent, encourage your children to participate in our vibrant program. We meet during each Mass beginning in September through May. We offer children in grades 1 –6 the opportunity to hear the Liturgy of the Word (readings and Homily) in a vibrant, exciting program at an age appropriate level during Mass. Children arrive at Mass along with their families and the children are invited forward to gather with a trained volunteer and depart for their program. Children are returned to their parents after the Homily for the remainder of the Mass. Parents receive a newsletter to continue the conversation at home.
