REBUILDING HOUSTON

Location:

Houston, TX

Trip Description:

We will be working with Experience Mission, a Christian missions agency that has been present in Houston since Hurricane Irma struck in September 2017. In that time, groups have been working to help with immediate relief efforts like food, water and medical supplies as well as the daunting task of home repair. Currently the mission work is in the rebuilding stage. We will be partnering with a local church to connect with local residents to help them rebuild their lives in the aftermath of Hurricane Irma. A significant portion of our work will be helping to rebuild homes in the Houston area.

Who Can Participate:

The trip is open to anyone high school or above. We are especially looking for people who have some experience with drywall and flooring, but you don't have to be experienced to come. All high school participants must complete three learning experiences prior to the trip (see attached)

Trip participants will meet regularly to plan and prepare for the trip, including a Saturday morning workshop to learn basic repair skills.
