## NEW ASSISTIVE LISTENING TECHNOLOGY IN SANCTUARY

Auracast is a new technology that allows for some hearing aids, earbuds, and headphones to receive a digital audio signal being broadcast by an Auracast transmitter. Auracast transmitters will become common in public spaces over time and can be used not just for hearing aids and assistive listening, but also in places like restaurants and workout facilities where there may be a variety of audio sources that guests or customers might want to listen to-for example, a gym with many TVs. In the last year, some hearing aid brands have introduced models that support Auracast: ReSound, Jabra, and Beltone all have capable models. Phonak, Philips, and Signia have indicated that some of their models will receive future firmware updates allowing them to receive the Auracast signal. The church has purchased and installed an Auracast transmitter for the sanctuary, and you may have seen Jeff Champeau and Stephanie Gasaway in worship testing it in recent weeks. We also purchased two standalone Auracast receivers that can be used with headphones, and they will be kept in the northwest corner of the Sanctuary. If you'd like to try one, pick it up before worship and return it to the charging base after. The existing telecoil/loopbased system has not been affected and will remain in place.
