Dear FCC Family,

By now, you may have heard that Rev. Shannon Cook has accepted the call to serve as Associate Regional Minister for the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) of Oklahoma. This news is bittersweet, so I would like to focus on four things:

**1. We will deeply miss Shannon.** For nearly 12 years, she has shepherded our youth (including my own) through their teenage years and into young adulthood. This is no small task, and Shannon—along with the support of her husband Bart and our youth sponsors—has made a lasting, positive impact on our children during a particularly vulnerable stage of their development. It has truly been a gift to entrust the spiritual growth of our youth to her.

**2. We are extremely proud of her.** The Regional Church of Oklahoma needs someone to do the vital work of supporting and growing youth ministry across the state, and they chose one of our own. Shannon's impact at the regional level will strengthen churches throughout Oklahoma and help them serve their youth in meaningful and effective ways.

**3. This time of transition is an opportunity for new beginnings and a fond farewell.** I have been in close contact with both Shannon and our new minister, Rev. Colton Lott, and we are all disappointed that Shannon and Colton will not have the opportunity to serve together at First Christian Church. However, we do have a transition plan in place and are working diligently to ensure that our youth program continues at the level we are accustomed to and that the youth mission trip will not be impacted. Shannon and Colton will still be working together, just in a different capacity.

**4. How we can show our appreciation.** We will hold a fellowship luncheon on Sunday, March 29, following the 10:45 service to thank and honor Shannon. A collection is being taken to present her with a monetary gift at the luncheon. If you would like to contribute, checks may be mailed to the church office with "Gift for Shannon" in the memo line. You may also donate online. Any amount is appreciated. Cards and personal notes of thanks are also deeply meaningful and welcomed.

Please join me in celebrating Shannon on March 29, and know that all will be well.


Lenten Devotional

This devotional offers a clear plan for spiritual transformation from Ash Wednesday to Easter.
