CONGREGATIONAL MEETING THIS SUNDAY

This Sunday, November 30, we will hold a congregational meeting immediately following both the 8:40 am and 10:45 am services. The purpose of this meeting is to seek congregational approval on funding for building security updates and IT (Information Technology) specialist support. Funding is to come from a budget surplus of the 2022-2025 capital campaign. All of the capital campaign items have been completed and invoices paid. Because of your generous giving and careful stewardship of projects and funds on the part of the Property Committee, there is enough money to fund both the security upgrades and hire IT support. A breakdown of the security upgrade budget was printed in *The Norman Christia*n on November 18.

This recommendation comes from the Financial Oversight Committee and was approved by the board on November 11. I ask that our church membership prayerfully consider this request.


