4. What stood out to you this week from John 9? (If you missed the message you can watch it online)
5. Of the characters in the story, (the blind man, Jesus, the disciples, the pharisees, the blind man's parents, the blind man's neighbors) which do you identify with most? Whose actions surprised you the most? Why?
6. Even with the doubts we all encounter, what are the undeniable things that lead you to daily put your faith in Jesus? Read John 9:25: Have you experienced this?
