#### **1. Member Care:**

What is something you are thankful for this week? What is something you are struggling with this week?

#### **2. Worship & Prayer:**

Let's make sure we have a proper perspective on God and who God is. Share the first word that comes to mind when you think about the character of God. Why that word?

#### **3. Loving Accountability:**

Take a few minutes to talk about how each of you are doing at following and fishing? How was your personal time with Jesus this past week, and did you share Jesus with anyone this week?

#### **4. Vision Casting:**

Let's remember why we are meeting together. We are called to be disciples of Jesus. A disciple is someone **who listens to Jesus, and does what he says**. (James 1:22) We are here to listen to Jesus and help each other obey.

#### **5. Lesson:**

This past Sunday we began a new series through the first 14 chapters of the book of Exodus.

A. Can you remember a time when you had to be rescued? What was that feeling like?

B. How familiar are you with the story of Exodus? What stands out to you about this book?

C. Sunday Frank talked about 5 major themes in the book, and how ultimately this story is our story as well. Of the 5 themes (God's presence, faithfulness, deliverance, power, and sacrifice) which one means the most to you right now?

D. Do you, at times, have difficulty trusting in these characteristics of God? Which one is the most difficult to hold onto in your life?

E. What things do you need deliverance from in your life right now?

F. What practical things can you do to accept the deliverance that God has given you? What can you do to help others understand the deliverance God has for them?

#### **6. Goal Setting:**

FOLLOWING: How will you listen to Jesus this week? Memorize Exodus 6:7 this week.

FISHING: Look for someone to share the hope of God's deliverance with.
