DISCUSSION:

- Every couple has conflict. Every relationship has conflict. What is a major conflict you have had in your marriage, dating relationship, or any relationship?
- Sunday we said 'the goal of healthy conflict is not to win, it is to come to a resolution in a way that honors God and honors one another'. Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not?
- How is the world's way of resolving conflict different then God's way?
- Sunday we talked about three commitments you can make deal with conflict well.  
1) Communicate Well, 2) Control Your Anger, 3) Create an environment of grace. Which of these do you need the most work on? Why?
- How can using 'I' statements and removing passive language change the way you communicate in conflict?
- Read Matthew 5:21-24, Ephesians 4:31-32: Is there forgiveness you need to seek or offer in any relationship in your life right now?
- Do you have a plan for resolving conflict? This week consider what a healthy plan could look like in your relationships.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Pray that God would reveal conflicts in relationships that you are currently managing. Pray for wisdom so that you can resolve these conflicts you have with others. Ask God to provide forgiveness that will heal and resolve conflict you have with others.
