THE BLESSING OF ECHOES

At first I thought my reflections suddenly came out of nowhere. But then I realized that there are many times in our lives when echoes from the past are most likely to happen.

While I am aware that not all echoes are pleasant, it is the positive ones that occupy me as I write this.

I am grateful that I still can conjure up the voices. Each of them is unique - of grandparents, parents, and other family members. I know there may come a day when I may have to struggle to bring them back, or even find it impossible to do. But for now they are one of the blessings of my life.

Some echoes become ingrained because we heard them day after day. That is not only true of family and friends but of teachers as well. Sometimes it is the echo of a minister or priestøs voice. I can still hear the rich Virginian drawl of my minister. He baptized me and years later was part of my ordination service. It is a warm and cherished voice of faith and comfort.

Easter time for me gives birth to some of those echoes. Memorable for me are those childhood Easters of walking to church with parents and my brother. Approaching the church we would greet others upon entering the sanctuary. Then we would be engulfed by organ music and thrilled with the aroma of the mass of flowers up front.

But, most of all, for Christians, it is the echo at the heart of the Easter story. Jesus said, õI am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me, though he die, yet shall he live, and whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die.ö (John 11:25-26).

May you and I always have those words lodged safely and permanently in our minds and hearts, for they are the echo of joy, life, and hope!

WINTER BROCCOLI CASSEROLE

- 2 10 oz pkg. frozen broccoli spears or fresh broccoli
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
- 2 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup finely chopped onion
- 34 cup herb-seasoned stuffing mix
- 2 Tbs butter or margarine, melted

Cook broccoli and drain well. Arrange broccoli in a lightly greased 11 x 7" baking dish. Sprinkle with cheese and set aside. Combine eggs and next 3 ingredients: spread over cheese. Combine stuffing mix and melted butter; sprinkle over casserole. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes or until thoroughly heated.
