Monthly Mission Emphasis

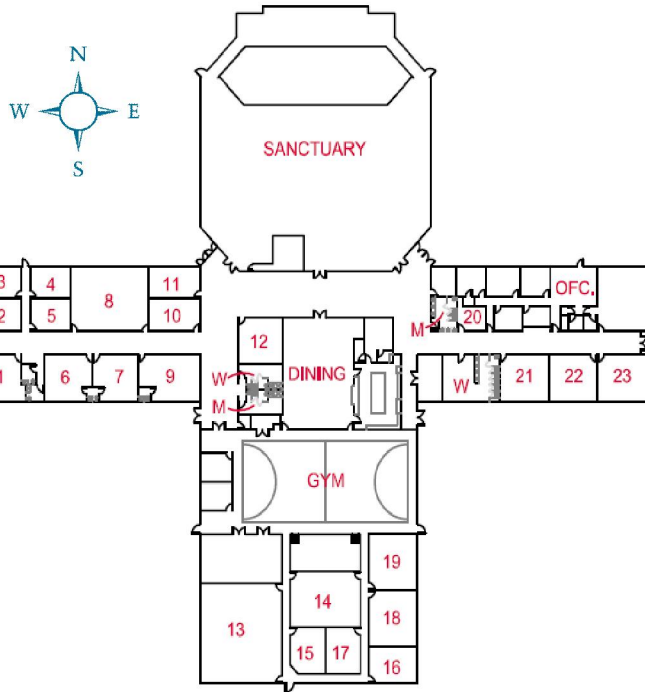
April: Mission Education

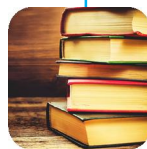
