Sunday Morning:

College/Career: We meet in "The Gathering Place" (east wing) at 7:00 p.m.

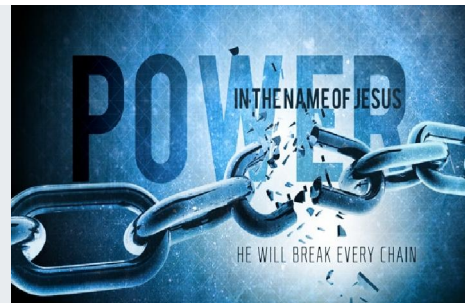
