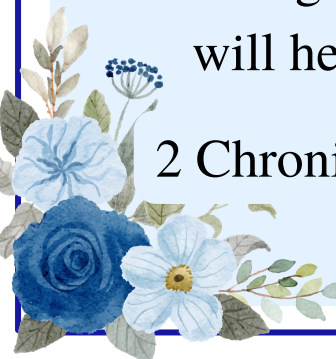
Today's Message

In the opening message of God's Recipe for Revival, we will explore God's first invitation in 2 Chronicles 7:14: “If My people...will humble themselves.” Through the Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector, we will discover how pride keeps us comparing, hiding, and defending ourselves—while humility opens our hearts to God's transforming grace.
