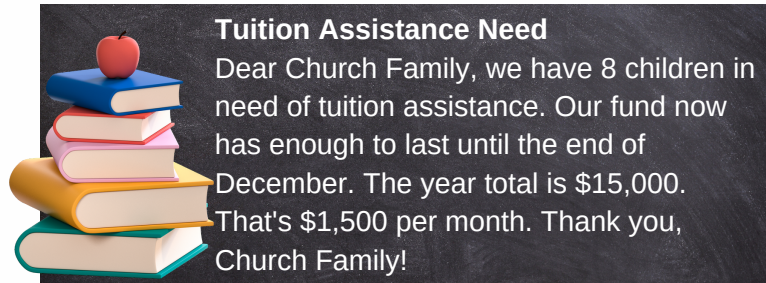

Sabbath Activity Bags - There are church activity bags for children to use during the service. They can be checked out in the mother's room before the service.

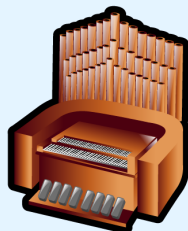
Pistachios are now available in the office. \$8.00 per bag. \$1.00 goes to the Church Library for new books.
