Hebrews 10:3-4, 8-10 "But those sacrifices are an annual reminder of sins.⁴ It is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.⁸ First he said, "Sacrifices and offerings, burnt

offerings and sin offerings you did not desire, nor were you pleased with them"—though they were offered in accordance with the law.⁹ Then he said, "Here I am, I have come to do your will." He sets aside the first to establish the second.¹⁰ And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."

Isaiah 53:3-5 "He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain.
