a. There are five heavenly crowns mentioned in the New Testament that will be awarded to _____.

1) The _____ Crown – **1 Corinthians 9:24-25**
 NKJV “Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it. And everyone who competes for the prize is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a perishable crown, but we for an imperishable crown.”

2) The Crown of _____ – **1 Thessalonians 2:19-20** NKJV “For what is our hope, our joy, or the crown in which we will glory in the presence of our Lord Jesus when he comes? Is it not you? ²⁰ Indeed, you are our glory and joy.”

- ♦ The crown of rejoicing _____ be our reward where “God will wipe away every tear . . . there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away” (**Revelation 21:4** NKJV).

3) The Crown of _____ – **2 Timothy 4:8** NKJV “Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.”

- ♦ This crown is _____ for those who depend upon their own sense of righteousness or of their own works.

4) The Crown of _____ – **1 Peter 5:4** NKJV “And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.”

5) The Crown of _____ – **Revelation 2:10** NKJV “Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.”

- ♦ We know that our earthly lives will end. But we have the amazing _____ that comes only to those who come to God through Jesus: “And this is the promise that He has promised us— eternal life” (**1 John 2:25** NKJV).

- ♦ **James 1:12** “Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.”
