**Psalms 139:1–6** (NASB) *O Lord, You have searched me and known me. 2 You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You understand my thought from afar. 3 You scrutinize my path and my lying down, And are intimately acquainted with all my ways. 4 Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, O Lord, You know it all. 5 You have enclosed me behind and before, And laid Your hand upon me. 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is too high, I cannot attain to it.*

**Psalms 139:13–18** (NASB95) *For You formed my inward parts; You wove me in my mother's womb. 14 I will give thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well. 15 My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret, And skillfully wrought in the depths of the earth; 16 Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And in Your book were all written The days that were ordained for me, When as yet there was not one of them. 17 How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How vast is the sum of them! 18 If I should count them, they would outnumber the sand. When I awake, I am still with You.*

**Psalms 139:23–24** (NASB95) *Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me and know my anxious thoughts; 24 And see if there be any hurtful way in me, And lead me in the everlasting way.*

**Malachi 3:16–17** (NASB) *Then those who feared the Lord spoke to one another, and the Lord gave attention and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before Him for those who fear the Lord and who esteem His name. 17 “They will be Mine,” says the Lord of hosts, “on the*

*day that I prepare My own possession, and I will spare them as a man spares his own son who serves him.”*

**1 Samuel 17:17,19** (NASB) *“...Take now for your brothers an ephah of this roasted grain and these ten loaves and run to the camp to your brothers... 19 “For Saul and they and all the men of Israel are in the valley of Elah, fighting with the Philistines.”*

**1 Samuel 17:8–10** (NASB) *“...Why do you come out to draw up in battle array? Am I not the Philistine and you servants of Saul? Choose a man for yourselves and let him come down to me. 9 “If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will become your servants; but if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall become our servants and serve us.” 10 ...“I defy the ranks of Israel this day; give me a man that we may fight together.”*

**1 Samuel 17:28** (NASB) *“...“Why have you come down? And with whom have you left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know your insolence and the wickedness of your heart; for you have come down in order to see the battle.”*

**Romans 8:37** (NASB) *“... in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.”*

**Philippians 4:13** (NASB) *I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.*

**1 Samuel 17:45–46** (NASB) *“... “You come to me with a sword, a spear, and a javelin, but I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have taunted. 46 “This day the Lord will deliver you up into my hands, and I will strike you down and remove your head from you...”*
