Volunteer Opportunities



Help us serve our neighbors at **Cartersville Gardens** during the Summer Feeding Program. It takes about an hour-and-a-half each day to serve the children who come.

The process is to swing by **Trinity at The Well** around 10:20am to pick up the serving tables and supplies. Then, arrive at the serving site at 10:30am for the delivery of the food from

the City School System. Distribute all of the meals to children aged 18 and younger, or people over 18 who have a disability. Once all of the meals have been distributed, one servant will return the meal containers to the cafeteria loading dock at Cartersville High School, and the other will return the tables to **Trinity at The Well**.

This is such a meaningful and special way to be in service to our neighbors. Thank you for helping care for all of God's children!

You can spend HOURS laughing, playing, learning, and growing *together* as a result of this simple night of fun.

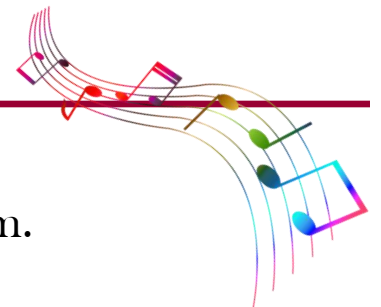
