MISSIONARY UPDATE: JAMES & SARAH LANGTEAU



Serving with Empower International in Pakistan, Myanmar, and Thailand James and Sarah are missionaries from our own local area (before serving overseas, James served in jail ministry in Marinette and Menominee). They now assist in training institutions, helping to train up national leaders in these countries.

A praise in February is that all the money needed has been raised to open a new Christian school in Pakistan! This school

will train 500 students to reach their own people with the gospel.

- Pray for safety and success as the school is built over the next year.
- Pray as James is teaching at Abraham Bible College in Myanmar.
 Myanmar is not a very open country, and equipping these believers with good Bible teaching is so important.
- Pray for safety both for James and for the believers there.
- Pray for funding for six national Myanmar missionaries. These six have had Bible training and have an ability to minister in their native tongues to their countrymen. Recently, they stopped receiving enough support. It only takes \$100 a month to support them. Pray that God will bring in this funding.

We currently give \$70.83 monthly to support James Langteau. Thank you for all that you give to help support our missionaries!
