

MON: Read Psalm 1:1-6. What does delight in the Law of the Lord look like? If great blessings come from dwelling on His Law, then make a plan to meditate on it this week!

- 1. Read Deuteronomy 5:21. How can breaking this last commandment lead to breaking the other commandments to love your neighbor before this one?
- 2. Read Genesis 3:1-6. How did the serpent coax Eve to take the forbidden fruit? What did she desire, and what did she see in the fruit that she wanted ... apart from God?




