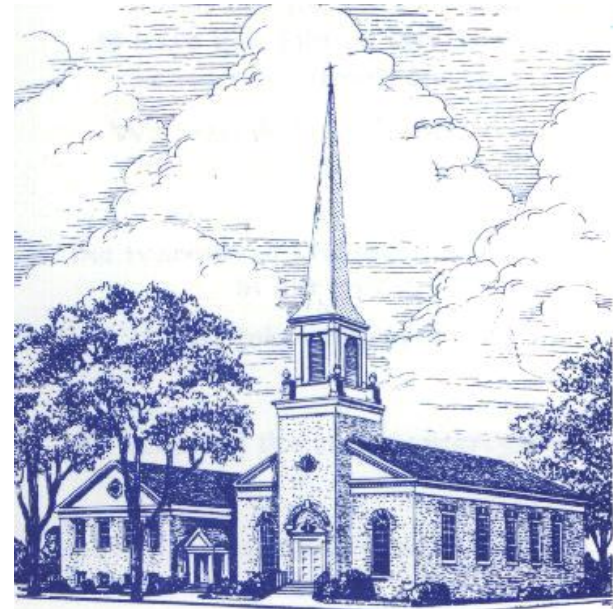
The roses on the lectern are in honor of:
