Angel Tree - Christmas Gifts

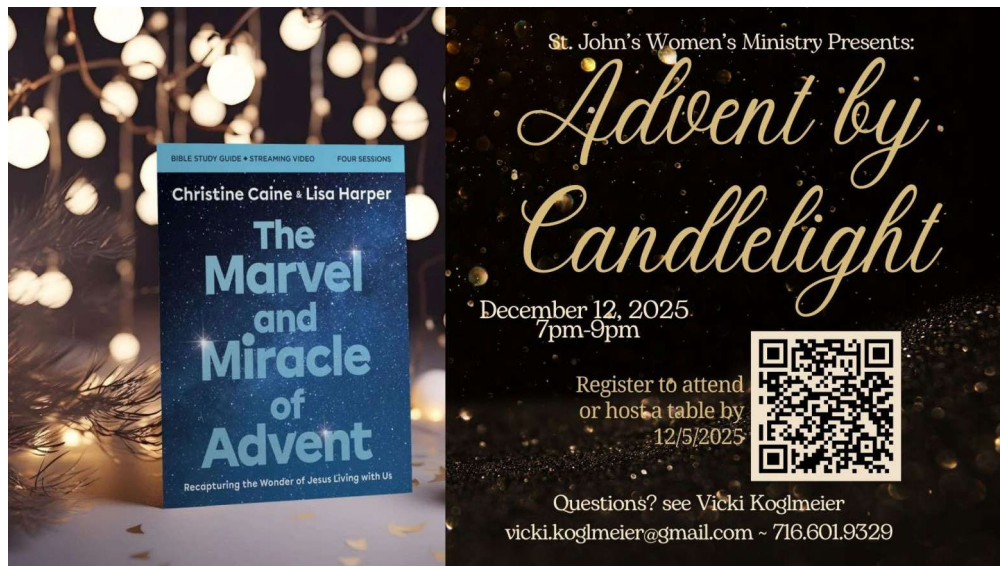

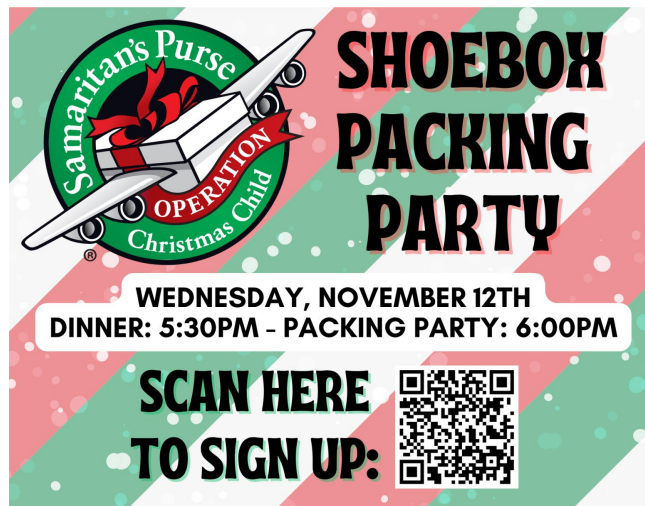

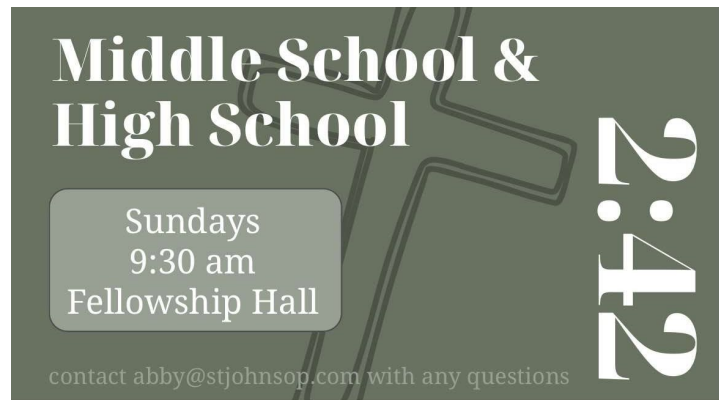
