## Food Offering for Bread of Life Pantry (Bin located in the Lobby)

The Bread of Life Outreach Center is a Christian ecumenical ministry of love and compassion, which recognizes the dignity inherent in all people. Drawing on the support, love and generosity of the community, we seek to follow the Gospel by feeding the hungry and clothing the naked. There are two sides to our outreach facility – the food pantry and Gabe's Closet.

The food pantry is set up like a grocery store, shopping carts are provided, and the families have a choice of foods. In order to participate qualifications of need must be met. Some of the items needed are: pasta, canned fruits & vegetables, juice, toilet paper, toothbrushes & toothpaste. A complete list can be found by the donation bin. Today we have expanded to helping 153 families or 341 people. These families are from Colden, Boston, Holland, West Falls, Glenwood, and South Wales within the five mile radius strongly suggested by Feedmore.

The clothing portion of the outreach is called Gabe's Closet. People donate gently used and brand new clothing for us to sell. From the sale of these items, we can purchase food for our clients. Gabe's is open to the public and accepts all clothing, shoes, and accessories. Our clients also receive a clothing allowance while with us.


