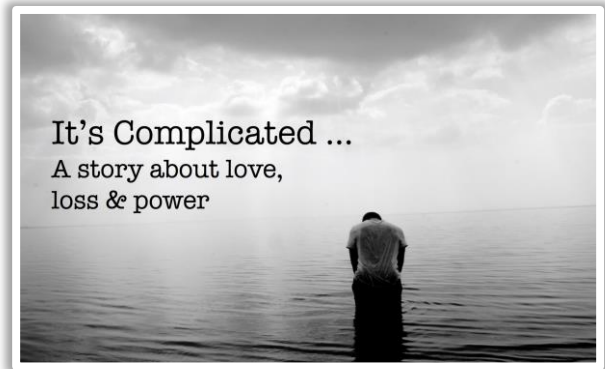


## This Week in Worship

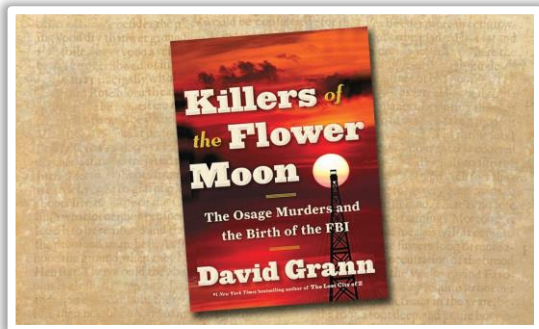


## Love Local – Food Truck Festival, July 14

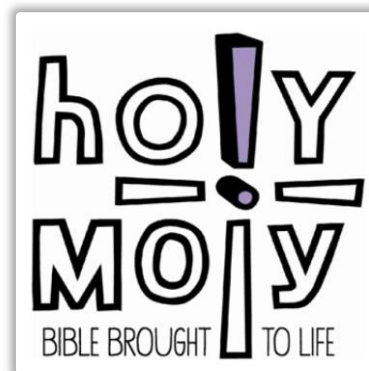


## All Church Read ...
