## For Solo Auditions:

Please be prepared to sing the first part of the very first song in the musical, entitled "Jingle Bell Beach." You may listen to the song on the YouTube link provided on the previous page, or on the Kids Choir Registration page. The words for the section you'll need to sing at audition are below:

We'll shred the surf and have some fun and walk down Sugarplum pier.

It's finally time to celebrate 'cause Christmas time is here!

## For All Speaking Part Auditions:

Please read through and familiarize yourself with the below scene, which is Scene 4 in the musical. Whether you're auditioning for a lead role, or a smaller speaking part, this is what you'll need to read at auditions. Practice reading ALL of the parts. It would be helpful to get a parent or sibling to read the other parts along with you as you practice.

## Scene 4

SANDY: (concerned) Snowflakes, You still look really really hot.

I'm going to get you all some cold water.

ASPEN: (standing strong) We prefer hot cocoa.

SONNY: (eyes widening) Alright. Three hot cocoas, coming up!

ASPEN: Getting nervous, 'Fishes?' (friendly taunting) Our winter

bliss got you shaking in your flip-flops?

LILY: Absolutely not, Snowflakeys. I'm afraid you're gonna

melt before the competition tonight.

ASPEN: (bragging) Oh, we have a secret weapon, you're not

going to believe!

ICELYN: (whispering) About that secret weapon, uhm, Aspen—?

COCO: (inquiringly) Ooo, what's the secret weapon?

ICELYN: (realizing the other groups' members are listening,

changing her delivery abruptly) It's, it's... gonna be

great!

ASPEN: You bet it is!

JANUARY: And then the Snowflakes will be the champions of

"Jingle Sing!"

LILY: (playful taunting) Except the Starfish will have already

surfed away with the trophy.

SONNY: Sounds like we might be in for a Reindeer Rumble!

ICELYNN: What's a Reindeer Rumble?

SANDY: It's a musical sing-off, but we haven't had one in

years.

ASPEN: The Snowflakes aren't afraid of a little sing-off!

COCO: Sounds great!

FIZZLE: (jumping in to try to start a fight that just isn't there)

Oooh! We want to rumble, too! Electrons are the

best! Whoo! Goooo, Eelctrons!

ALL: (pause)

ASPEN: (turning to the others) I have absolutely no issue with

them.

LILY: (in agreement) Me, neither.

COCO: (enthusiastically) I love Christmas lights!

SPARKTON: (confused) But we... we're the best! (Menacingly) Don't

you want to rumble?

CATCHER: (smiling) No, dude! We love you, guys!

FIZZLE: (at a loss) Okay. We'll just (pause) practice our song

over near the delivery box to talk privately.)

ICELYN: (cheerily) Lots of luck! (changing tone) Uh, January,

may I speak with you?

JANUARY: Sure, Icemen! What's up?

ICELYN: There's a bit of a problem with our secret weapon.

JANUARY: With the snowman? What do you mean?

ICELYN: It's... well... let me show you. (Icelyn opens box just

enough for January to look inside)

JANUARY: (blankly) What am I looking at? There's nothing in

here.

ICELYN: **Exactly.**
