

Board of Administration

The Gateway Conference Board of Administration met five times during the 2018-2019 conference year under the leadership of the BOA chair, Mike Aden. In addition, one email vote occurred on a single issue item. Issues of policy, property, and finance were handled, as well as other conference business.

October 4, 2018

On motion: The Board approved the purchase of the property located at 207 N. 17th Street, Kansas City, Kansas 66101

On motion: The Board approved giving the Wick Anderson family \$2,000 as start-up funds to become missionaries in Hungary.

November 29, 2018

On motion: The Board approved the following: After careful consideration of past support, current Restore Network needs, suitability to our grant "areas of support" and the effectiveness of the organization, the grant committee recommends that an award of \$5,000 be granted to the Restore Network.

December 18, 2018

On motion: The Board approved a grant of \$5,000 to the Greenville Free Methodist Church for the Celebrate Recovery program. The committee will re-evaluate after one year to determine the granting of additional funds.

February 7, 2019

On motion: The Board approved the forming of an exploratory group to discuss next steps toward the building of a finished garage to be utilized as a sanctuary with potential costs of \$40,000 for Come to Jesus.

On motion: The Board approved the Rushville Camp's offer of \$2,000 for the sale of the trust clause and 10 years of one week of family camp with them paying all legal fees.
