# NINTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

August 02, 2020

**AS WE GATHER** *(To focus our thoughts and prepare our hearts for worship.)*

Each of the lessons for today has a mission theme. The prophet Isaiah said that foreigners— people outside the traditional "house of Israel"---would be gathered into God's presence. Yet Jesus tested the faith of the Canaanite woman saying, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Paul also struggles to explain who can be saved, the "house of Israel" only, or also the Gentiles? Since Jesus healed the daughter of the Canaanite woman, he indicated clearly that salvation through Him is intended for all people. Today we celebrate that Jesus came to seek and to save the lost, no matter what their background.
