### Volunteer Opportunities

*ACTION was born out of a desire to network churches, agencies, and businesses together to collectively serve the needs throughout the community. It engages thousands of volunteers to serve on hundreds of projects which focus primarily on seniors, disabled residents, under resourced families, the homeless population, and at risk youth.*

### Community Christmas Shoppe

Serve in the areas of gift wrapping, child care, food service, personal shopper, entertainment, and more.

- Groups can serve leading up to the event to sort toys, prepare rooms, prepare crafts, etc.
- Occurs the Saturday two weeks after Thanksgiving.

### Serve Day

We serve the Samaritan Center, Sarah's House, CPC, senior centers, schools, residents in mobile home parks, assisted living, nursing homes, and individuals.

- Activities include running sports camps for foster kids
- Bringing blankets to shut-in seniors
- Sit down projects
- Yard work for residents
- Collecting goods
- Beautification projects (Occurs the first Saturday in May)

### Serve Every Day

Provide different services to meet practical needs with your personal skills.

- Provide services for a resident's home including handyman work, skilled labor, yard work, and cleaning
- Give your time to visit a lonely senior, drive someone to the doctor, or help someone organize their home.
- Occurs throughout the year as needs arise

### Office Assistance

Lend your general office skills to helping the office run smoothly.

- Answering phones, filing, organizing, mailings, data entry
- Design graphics, documents, posters
- Solicit toy donations, Serve Day supplies, materials for projects
- Photographers and Videographers to document programs and projects to tell our story
- Bilingual help in phone work, documents, etc.
- Event team members to help put on programs, trainings, volunteer appreciations, fundraising galas, specialty events, etc.
  - Occurs throughout the years as needs arise

- Help with resume writing
- Teach basic computer skills
