

Life Group Position Focus – “Leader”

Purpose

The Life Group Leader plays an essential role in helping create the environment and opportunities for group members to experience God and life transformation through encouraging and challenging one another to become passionate Christ-followers who are pursuing God, loving others, serving sacrificially and sharing Christ.

Qualifications

A Life Group Leader is a passionate Christ-follower who is a Partner at The Church at Rocky Peak and:

1. Is a person of *character*: growing in obedience to Christ
2. Is a person of *competency*: relates well with others, facilitates group meetings well
3. Is a person who embraces our *culture*: buys into and promotes the vision, values and strategies of Rocky Peak
4. Is a person of *commitment*: faithfully fulfills the responsibilities listed below

Responsibilities

Key areas of responsibility for the Life Group Leader include:

1. Fulfills the purpose of the Life Group Leader
 - Helps create the environment and opportunities for group members to experience God and life transformation
 - Encourages and challenges one another to become passionate Christ-followers who are pursuing God, loving others, serving sacrificially and sharing Christ
2. Is intentional in leading group members and meetings
 - Helps members connect with each other
 - Prays with and for members
 - Facilitates discussion times, sharing and prayer each week
3. Maintains communication with the Life Group Leadership Team
 - Assures weekly attendance is submitted
 - Meets with a Life Group Director regarding the health of the group
 - Communicates group updates and changes accurately and timely
 - Supports each Life Group session sign-up and launch
4. Life Group Multiplication
 - Recruits and develops new leaders with a view toward launching a new group after three sessions
 - Identifies and partners with the Life Group Host as a part of the Life Group Leadership Team
5. Leadership training
 - Completes New Life Group Leadership Training
 - Attends all Life Group Leadership Gatherings: Fall, Winter, Spring
