

WHO IS MEGA SUMMER CAMP FOR?

Our elementary camps (art, basketball, cheer, drama and soccer) are for kids in 1st-6th grade for the 2019-2020 school year. Our mini-camp is for kids ages 4-5 (K-4 and Kindergarten) and are fully potty trained.

9 AM – 1:30 PM – Friday (Camps are followed by an All Camp Celebration beginning at 12:15 PM)

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Online registration can be completed at www.graceofbelair.com/events/mega-summer-camp. Online registration begins Monday, April 29th and ends on Saturday, August 3rd.

We strongly encourage families to use the online registration and payment process through our “donate” web page to enroll their children. The registration is not complete and the child will not be guaranteed a spot until full payment has been received.

Several of our camps do fill up quickly, so be sure to register and pay early to ensure your child’s spot.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

\$30 per child – which includes a camp t-shirt, drawstring backpack, water bottle, daily healthy snacks, and the all camp celebration activities.

We do provide family discounts for larger families. First two children are regular price, additional children receive a 50% discount. All children registered under one family name must be immediate family members in order to receive the discount.

WILL MY CHILD BE ABLE TO CHOOSE A DIFFERENT CAMP TO ATTEND EACH DAY?

Once your child is registered for a specific camp, they will attend that camp for all FIVE (5) days. Due to enrollment limitations, we may or may not be able to make adjustments once camp begins.

CAN I CHANGE WHICH CAMP I SIGNED MY CHILD UP TO ATTEND?

Changes can only be made prior to the first day of camp. Once camp begins, we cannot guarantee there will be room for your child to attend a different camp.

WHAT IF I SIGNED MY CHILD UP FOR THE WRONG CAMP?

If there is still space available in a particular camp, we can make adjustments prior to the first day of camp. Please double check your choice before finalizing your registration.

WILL WE BE ABLE TO REGISTER OUR KIDS AT THE DOOR?

Registration will be available at the door, however, we encourage early registration as some of our camps will be full prior to the first day of camp. We can also not guarantee that we will have t-shirts available in the correct sizes for your child. If they are pre-registered in advance, it also guarantees that they won't miss the start of the rallies and activities on Monday morning.

CAN MY CHILD BRING THEIR OWN EQUIPMENT OR PERSONAL ITEM?

We encourage them to bring personal gear which will help with their specific camp (i.e. basketball, soccer ball, shin guards, etc.). Please clearly mark your child's name on any balls and/or equipment they may bring for each appropriate sport.

We also highly encourage your elementary child to bring a beach towel to use to sit on while outside for breaks.

WHAT IS THE PROPER DRESS FOR THE CAMP?

Please have your child dress appropriately for their specific camp, including socks and shoes for all sports (no flip-flops or sandals permitted), t-shirts and shorts for cheerleading (no mini shorts, dresses or skirts please). Those attending art camp should bring an art smock (a men's t-shirt works great!).

CAN I DROP OFF MEDICATION FOR MY CHILD?

Our leaders cannot administer medications of any kind, however, we do strongly encourage those campers who need Epi-pens and/or Inhalers to carry them at all times. An identified wristband will be given to campers with these items or those who have allergies. All Epi-pens and/or inhalers must be labeled with current prescription information.

WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS A FOOD ALLERGY?

We provide in advance a list of our daily menu for snacks. All snacks are nut-free, however, if your child has any other food allergies (milk, eggs, gluten, etc.) we ask that you provide a snack from home that they can eat during our half-time rally.

WHEN SHOULD I PICK MY CHILD UP FROM MSC?

All children should be picked up at 12 noon. Parents may attend the opening and closing rallies, but must sit in the designated parents seating areas.

HOW DO YOU PROVIDE SECURITY AT MEGA SUMMER CAMP?

All children receive a wrist band when they arrive on Monday, and each parent/guardian receives a security card with the corresponding family security number. You will need to show your security card to our team members as you exit each day to verify you are picking your child up. If you need more than one security card, please see our registration team members to ask for additional cards.

WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS?

Our event will take place rain or shine.

WHERE DO WE ENTER THE BUILDING AFTER ARRIVING ON CAMPUS?

You can enter through the main entrance, located on the left side of the building. If you are pre-registered, you will pick up your child's backpack at the tables to the left when you enter. If you still need to register, you would go to the window on the right to complete registration.

WHAT IS THE ALL CAMP CELEBRATION ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 9?

Our all camp celebration is a hot dog lunch, followed by fun water activities on a giant slip and slide. We recommend that families bring lawn chairs or picnic blankets for the hour & 15 minute celebration.
