## Ten Commandments Lesson 7

### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: NO MURDER, NO HATE



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

God created every life, and every life is precious to him. We should treat each other as precious. Genesis 4:1-16, Cain and Abel, Matthew 5:21-22, Do Not Murder



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

As a family, try to police yourselves this week and resist the urge to speak in anger or bitterness or hate. When someone is feeling hurt by someone else, pray with them. Ask God how you can respond to them with love.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What does Jesus say is just as bad as committing murder?
- Why is it important to love people who are hateful to us?
- How can we show love when someone hurts us or makes us angry?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"The law of the Lord is perfect. It gives us new strength. The laws of the Lord can be trusted. They make childish people wise." Psalm 19:7 (NIRV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

How often do you yell at the referee during a sports game, in person or on TV? Do you trash talk? Do you gossip? Do you let your emotions send you into a verbal tirade? Ask God to help you set an example for your children by using words for good instead of hate. Encourage your kids to do the same, especially when they tell you they have been hurt or let down by someone else.
