Keeping Christmas Simple

So what could those steps look like for you? Maybe it's showing up and setting aside time for your family this Christmas. Maybe it's designating five quiet minutes each morning to pray. Maybe it's opening your Bible more often, or reaching out to encourage a friend. Maybe it's even taking care of your body by moving a little more each week.

These small steps might not seem like much, but each one leads you closer to the Lord and to the life He's calling you to live. Over time, simple faithfulness becomes beautiful transformation.

This season, let's remember: Big change often begins in small, humble ways — just like that night in Bethlehem.

Heavenly Father, In this busy season, help me to slow down and remember what truly matters. Teach me to find joy in the simple things — in quiet moments, small

acts of kindness, and daily faithfulness. Thank You for sending Jesus in such a humble way, showing us that greatness begins with surrender and simplicity.

As I step into the new year, guide me to take small, steady steps toward You. Let my heart stay centered on Your love and truth, and may my hands ready to serve, and my spirit willing to grow one step at a time.

As we look ahead to 2026, Sunset Point Christian Camp is excited to continue growing and strengthening our Camp community. To make this possible, we're inviting you to partner with us through your year-end giving.

Our mission remains strong — to care for and improve our facilities so the Camp can continue to be a place where lives are changed and faith is strengthened. Your gift helps us maintain and renew the Camp you love, while living out the Christian values of generosity and love for our neighbours.

Several projects and improvements that took place in 2025, because of your financial giving, volunteerism and commitment to the Camp included;

- The Electrical Project to enhance power service throughout the Camp.
- Mini Golf Park - New structures have been built for all eighteen holes, and the shed has a new roof and siding. The park will open for use in the spring of 2026. (See pictures below).
- Pump House - The pump house required vital repairs to maintain the integrity of the structure, and a new roof, insulation and siding were completed to maximize its usage. (See pictures below).

- Added surge protectors to the pump house and Elim Lodge boiler systems to enhance the safety, longevity, and reliability of electrical and electronic devices in those facilities.

As we move into 2026, additional upgrades are underway as follows;

- Fire Alarm Panel - The Christian Center needs a new fire alarm panel to ensure dependable protection, compliance with current codes, and the safety of everyone who uses the facility.
- Elim Lodge Dining Room - Requires painting, and a new feature wall will be completed at the same time to enhance the atmosphere and overall group experience.
- Gym/Dining Hall Floor, Chairs & Storage Racks - The Camp is very pleased to announce that we have received funding to replace the gym/dining hall floor and the chairs in the Christian Center. The Camp would like to express our gratitude to the two foundations that provided funds to make this vital upgrade possible.

As we move forward into 2026, you continue to be a vital part of the Camp's story. Thank you for your support through 2025 and the years before. Thanks to many generous supporters, we've already seen great momentum — and with your help, we can reach our next goal.
